Visual Identity

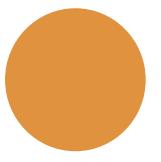
Color palette: Stays true to to the fall season but the colors are slightly on the duller side to enhance the imagery and the products and not overpower them.

Note: Do not use any color at 100% for photography backgrounds.



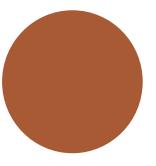
